

EUREKA CHARTER TOWNSHIP BOARD MINUTES
MONDAY, OCTOBER 14, 2013

Supervisor Rodney Roy, at the Eureka Township Hall, 9322 S. Greenville Road, Greenville, MI, called the Regular Meeting of the Eureka Charter Township Board to order on Monday, October 14, 2013, at 7:00 pm. After the Pledge of Allegiance, roll call found the following Board Members present: Supervisor Rodney Roy, Clerk Linda Ruwersma, Treasurer Cindy Hanson, Trustees Jeremy Austin, Elaine Pendrick, and Brad Kelley. Trustee Marty Posekany was absent. These minutes will not be approved until the November 11, 2013 Regular Board Meeting.

Approximately fourteen others were in attendance including Deputy Clerk Michele Bigelow, Planning Commission Members Mark Wilkin and Linda Weger; County Commissioner Tom Lindeman, Zoning Official Tom Faussett, Assessor Linda Miller, City Councilmembers Fran Schuleit and Brian Greene; and Deputy Doug Houser.

During the first Public Comment Deputy Houser commented on some of the safety procedures during the Tour De Donuts recently held at Klackle Orchards. There was also some discussion if golf carts on roads will be legalized. Commissioner Lindeman gave an update concerning County issues and on the County budget.

Mr. Tim Rozelle from Retirement Plan Advisors was present to discuss the Township's Security Benefit Retirement 457 Program. He stated anyone earning money from the Township is eligible to participate in the plan.

Trustee Pendrick moved, with a second by Trustee Kelley to approve the items on the October 14, 2013 Agenda and the Consent Agenda. Motion carried.

Approving the Consent Agenda included accepting the September 9, 2013 Board Minutes as written and the payment of the bills for September in the amount of \$146,212.05 covering e-bills 354-364 and checks numbering 13346-13389. The Treasurer's report showed an ending balance of \$704,516.90 as of September 30, 2013.

The consent agenda also included the zoning report from Mr. Tom Faussett showing 80 hours for September; the Greenville Transit report showing 273 runs; the Flat River Library report; and the Building report showing 4 permits for June and one for July. There was no fire report.

Deputies Charlie Mahar and Doug Houser were assigned to Eureka Township for the month of September. The sheriff report showed a total of 4,416 patrol miles, with 206.5 patrol hours, 63 traffic stops, 20 traffic citations, 126 property inspections, and one arrest.

Supervisor Roy reported that the Township Cleanup Day held on Saturday, September 14, 2013, was again a success. All four trash dumpsters were filled and metal was brought for the Greenville Steel dumpster. He also stated that there is a recycler out of
